ASPHALT DRUM PLANT PLANNED IN EAST FLAT ROCK

A conditional rezoning application #R-2020-03-C was submitted on behalf of SE Asphalt on May 1, 2020, which requests Henderson county conditionally rezone a 6.5 acre portion of land to a conditional district to construct a new hot mix asphalt plant located off Spartanburg Highway (US 176) and US – 25 in East Flat Rock, NC.

Health Impact, Air, Water & Noise Pollution:

Asphalt fumes are known toxins. Exposure to these air toxics may cause cancer, central nervous system problems, liver damage, respiratory problems, and skin irritation.

Potential pollution of nearby Laurel Creek and the Green River. Noise from other asphalt plants can be heard at least a mile away.

Loss of Property Value:

A property value study conducted by the Blue Ride Environmental Defense League (BREDL) documented losses of up to 56% percent because of the presence of a nearby asphalt plant.

They will make a recommendation to the Board of Commissioners who will make a final decision.
